METHOD OF BURNING

Open Pile In Place Air Curtain Destructor

If the burning is for Hoover/Jefferson County, you must have a Jefferson County Health Department permit issued before Hoover Fire will issue a permit. Hoover/Shelby County requires only a Hoover Permit.

- No burning from May 1st through October 31st.
- Asphalt materials, tires, synthetic rubber or any other non-vegetable matter may not be burned.
- Fire must be constantly attended.
- No burning shall take place when atmospheric conditions (high winds) make such fires hazardous.
- All burning should be:
 - 150 feet from the closest road
 - 500 feet from an occupied dwelling
 - 1500 feet from any church, nursing home, ballpark or large gathering.
- Must have permanent water source readily available.
- Burning shall commence after 9:00AM and no other material added after 3:00PM.
- Permit expires after 30 days.
- Other restrictions noted by Fire Inspector or Health Department.
- No burning during Red Flag Warnings.
