This permit is subject to all laws, rules, and regulations of the City of Hoover and may be revoked at any time by the Fire Marshal or his authorized representative if any of the listed conditions are violated.

**Hot Roof Work:**

IFC 303.2 Location. Asphalt (tar) kettles shall not be located within 20 feet of any combustible material, building surface or building opening. Kettles shall not block any means of egress or be located on inside a building or on the roof.

IFC 303.3 Location of fuel containers shall be at least 10 feet away from the burner.

IFC 303.4 an operating kettle shall be attended by a minimum of one employee knowledgeable in the operation and hazards. The employee shall be within 100 feet of the kettle and within site.

**Welding and Cutting:**

305.2 No combustible trash/material within 10 feet of work area.

308.4 Persons utilizing a torch or other flame producing device shall remain on site for a minimum of 1 hour after work has stopped.

**ALL HOT WORK SHALL HAVE FIRE EXTINGUISHERS ON SITE WITHIN 25 FEET OF WORK. AT A MINIMUM THE EXTINGUISHER SHALL HAVE A 4A,20B-C RATING. FOR ROOF WORK A SECOND EXTINGUISHER SHALL BE PLACED ON THE ROOF.**
